The competition will be conducted as follows:

- 1- Judging Phase: Four animals are judged by each competitor and placing 1 to 4 recorded on a judging card marked "Non - oral". 10 minutes will be allowed to judge this class.
- 2- Oral Phase: Each competitor selected from the judge's results will have 2 min to speak on his/her placing/s.
- 3- Champion and Reserve Judges will be awarded to the top two overall point scores.

BEEF CATTLE PARADERS- Section 2

Friday 1st November 2023

Commencing 3.00 pm (Approx)

- Competitors in the group final must be over 13 & under 19 at the 1st of May 2025- Up to ten (10) competitors (depending on the number of entries) will be eligible for the State Final at 2025 Royal Easter Show.

PRIZES: 1st \$15.00, 2nd, \$10.00, 3rd \$5.00 (*unless otherwise stated*)

The competition will be conducted as follows:

1. It is a condition that all cattle must be steers or females.
2. 1st place getters are eligible for champion. 2nd to Champion is eligible for Reserve Champion Junior Parader.
3. Ages to coincide with "State" Final at Sydney Show.
4. Competitors will be divided into heats on the day.
5. Each competitor may enter only one class in the Paraders' Section.

6. **Competitors, please note rule change:**

Once a competitor has qualified to represent a Group at Sydney Royal Show in any one of the Judging or Parading Competition State Finals, **he/she may not enter another Group Final as a potential qualifier in that type of competition in that competition year.** He/she can, however, enter any one or more Group Finals anywhere in the state, for practice (and score), in the same type of competition as one in which he/she has previously qualified as long as he/she discloses this to the Group Final organisers at the time of entry and indicates that he/she is not eligible for a placing in that event.
(*"qualified" means in Beef Cattle*).

PROTESTS & PROCEDURES

- a) A protest or complaint against any exhibit or exhibitor may be lodged verbally with the Chief Steward of the relevant section no later than ten minutes after the of judging of the exhibit or exhibitor. The Chief Steward must be provided with the exact nature of the complaint and act, if necessary, to maintain competitive fairness. The Chief Steward may choose to refer the matter to the Protests Committee, which shall comprise the President of the Society, or a Vice President and two other members of the General Committee.
- b) A protest or complaint or an appeal against the decision of a Chief Steward may be lodged in writing with the Secretary no later than 10 pm on the day of judging. Such protest, such complaint or appeal shall be accompanied by a deposit of \$50 which, shall be forfeited if the protest, complaint or appeal proves to be frivolous or vexatious. A matter lodged this way shall be dealt with by the Protests Committee within 24 hours of lodgement and the decision of the Protest Committee shall be final. NB: No protest or complaint will be considered if it refers simply to a judge's decision.
- c) Any exhibitor or associate who behaves offensively on the Showground will be removed from the Showground and may be refused future admission.
- d) No exhibitor or associate will initiate conversation with a judge on judging day, before during or after judging.
- e) The Show Society will be the sole arbiter on any question of the eligibility of an entry.

- 1- All exhibits must be accompanied by a signed and correctly completed **Official National Vendor Declaration (NVD)** which must be handed to a steward upon arrival.
- 2- Albury Showground PIC is NF321972
- 3- All cattle **must be NLIS tagged**
- 4- **All cattle** and all exhibitions must provide a **clearly printed PIC** on their entry form.
- 5- In addition, a **National Cattle Health Declaration** must be supplied with entries. All cattle must be Pestivirus tested with proof of negative result required.
- 6- All cattle entered are to conform to RAS Requirements.
- 7- All cattle 12 months and over are to be fitted with a led with a nose ring/clips at all times.
- 8- Handlers must be over 12 years of age to lead a bull.

- 1st Place getters are eligible for Champion. 2nd to Champion is eligible for reserve.

Hoof Prizes: 1st \$30.00, 2nd, \$20.00, 3rd \$10.00 (*unless otherwise stated*)

- 1- An entry to consist of one steer or heifer. Exhibitors are not restricted to one entry per class (breed and sire must be stated on entry form).
- 2- All cattle must be mouthed & **NLIS tagged** by exhibitor. Incorrect mouths or lack of identification will render the exhibit ineligible. A **clearly printed PIC** of origin must appear on the entry form.
- 3- All cattle to be entered for both sections of the competition- Hook & Hoof will be slaughtered at an abattoir of the Society's discretion.
- 4- The Society undertakes to market the carcass to the best advantage of the exhibitor, but the discretion in regards to price rests entirely with the Society. Any expenses incurred by the Society by way of Government Charges will be deducted from the proceeds. The exhibitor has the right to retain the carcass. The Society will deduct 3% of proceeds for administration costs. Proceeds will not be available for up to 35 days after carcass judging. Please complete your banking details & ABN (or Hobby) on your entry form. By providing this information, it enables prompt processing by the Society to deposit proceeds directly into your bank account.
- 5- The Society undertakes to transport the cattle from the showground to the abattoirs.
- 6- Cattle must be polled or dehorned to within 3cm of the head. Bruising will not be taken into consideration when judging.
- 7- Live cattle will be judged for market suitability.
- 8- The Committee reserves the right to alter or change the class weights and/or classification of classes.
- 9- All Hook Prizes awarded subject to chemical residue clearances correctly completed.
- 10- Correctly completed LLS (Local Land Services) National Vendor Declarations (**destination Ascot Meats**) must accompany exhibits and be given to Steward on arrival. Albury Showground PIC is NF321972.
- 11- Only enter each beast in the (Live) section, (HSW or Hook will be done automatically).

HOOF & HOOK- Section 4

TRADE VEALER-

One beast; milk teeth only, hot standard carcass weight between 190kg & 220kg with 5 to 10mm of fat at the p8 site.

The Committee recommends a live weight of 310kg to 410kg depending on dressing percentage.

SUPERMARKET TRADE-

One beast; up to two (2) teeth only, hot standard carcass weight between 221kg & 250kg with 6 to 13mm of fat at the p8 site.

The Committee recommends a live weight of 410kg to 480kg depending on dressing percentage.

HEAVY SUPERMARKET TRADE-

One beast; up to two (2) teeth only, hot standard carcass weight to go over 250kg with 9 to 15mm of fat at the p8 site.

The Committee recommends a live weight of 481kg or over depending on dressing percentage.
